Logistics, Transportation, Export & Customs Procedures, and Brexit Implications

A one day course on Logistics, Transportation, Export & Customs Procedures and Brexit Implications is to be given from 8:30am to 5pm on Monday 20th May 2019 in the Red Cow Hotel, Dublin.

The Logistics, Transportation, Export & Customs Procedures, and Brexit Implications Course will also cover EDI logistics transactions, modes of transport, route and carriers selection, export & customs procedures and documentation, and a Customs and Brexit implications overview.

This one day course would be suitable for administrators, coordinators, planners, team leads and managers in the areas of Logistics, Transport, Distribution, Shipping, Freight Forwarding, Export & Customs Procedures, and Brexit implications.

e.g. Lo-Lo, Ro-Ro, 20' & 40' Containers, trailers, Refrigerated, Temperature Controlled, Low Loaders, Bulk, etc.,
- Route and Carriers Selection for your market – Choosing freight forwarders, Carriers, 3PL / 4PL
- Export Procedures and Documentation - Market specific documentation EU and USA examples
- Export Licences, Health Certs, Certs of Origin
- Bills of Lading / Waybills
- Incoterms 2010

Customs and Brexit implications overview to include:

- Give an insight to the basis of Customs Rules, the importance of the single market and how the withdrawal of the UK from the single market will impact trade.
- How Duties and other taxes work along with an insight in to the origin and use of Commodity codes and some simple examples of Duty and VAT calculations along with an insight of how IT can and is applied to the process of Customs declarations.

Customs formalities for trade between EU and Non-EU countries are outlined in the Union Customs Code. With the imminent departure of the UK from the EU the expectation from the EU is that Customs formalities for trade between the UK and Ireland will be a necessary requirement to keep in line with the Union Customs Code. A broad outline of these

requirements and how to fulfill them will be discussed and with particular focus on import and export requirements in addition to those required by your carriers to insure a smooth transition of goods in and out of the European Union.
